NOTES:

The crew shall give twenty four hours notice before leaving or otherwise forfit a days pay. And the crew shall be entitle to twenty four hours notice before being discharged. Any member of the crew loosing his passage shall be considered as a deserter and shall forfit his claims to the ship and wages due to him, and the crew shall individual pay any fine incurred by them through neglect of Post in harbour Regulation Tide Watch Lights or smoking X Cetra and the crew mutule to assist each other to work the ship when required and to coal the ship when required.
