Notice. - This Agreement is to be used only for Voyages made on the Coasts of the United Kingdom, or to the Islands of Jersey, Guernsey, Alderney, Sark, and Isle of Man, or to places on the Continent of Europe between the River Elbe and Brest, inclusive. The Crew need not be engaged before a Superintendent. On whatever date the Agreement is made it expires on the next following 30th day of June or 31st day of December, as the case may be, and is then, or within 21 days afterwards, to be delivered to the Superintendent of a Mercantile Marine Office. If however, the Ship is absent from the United Kingdom on the 30th day of June or 31st day of December, then this Agreement remains in force until the first arrival of the Ship at her final port of destination in the United Kingdom after such day, or the discharge of cargo consequent on such arrival, when it is to be delivered up to a Superintendent.

On this Agreement and Account of Crew being duly completed and deposited at a Mercantile Marine Office, the Superintendent will issue the Certificate C.C., to enable

the Ship to be cleared at the Custom House.

Neglect to deposit the returns within the time prescribed by the Merchant Shipping Act subjects the owner or Master to a penalty, and will lead to delay in the issue of the Clearance Certificate and consequent detention of the Ship.
