21 Dec 1909, when about 4 miles E of the North Arklow Lightship we encountered a heavy S.E. gale and owing to heavy sea breaking over the ship carried away port gauway also doing seenby damages and we were obliged to knock away Culworks and cut jib halyards and topsail to free the ship from water awning at Dublin, 22 Dec 1909.
