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1 Jul 1911 to 13 Nov 1911 sailed between Bridgwater and Liverpool.

On 12 November 1911 at 11:30 pm, the vessel was struck by a heavy sea over the stern, 5 miles off Strumble Head, North Wales. John Champion the ships Mate was washed overboard and drowned.

John Champion's character in ability and conduct recorded as "VG"; Last place of Abode: No. 3 Whitehead Buildings, Bridgwater; Nationality: British; Born: South Shields.
